RULES and REGULATIONS

All participants AGREE to adhere to the L.A. County Department of Public Health COVID-19 orders in place during the 2022 San Fernando Valley Veterans Day Parade.

1. <u>VETERANS WITH FAMILY MEMBERS AND ONLY VETERANS WITH FAMILY MEMBERS RIDE IN THIS PARADE.</u>

- 2. Any unit not in by 10:30 a.m. will be put at the end of the parade. The parade will begin promptly at 11:11 am. SHARP All units are required to carry an identification number and must be displayed at all times on the right side of the unit.
- 3. The Parade Staging Director will space each unit at the start of the parade. HOLD THS FORMATION!
- 4. NO STOPPING IN FRONT OF THE VIP/REVIEW STAND.
- 5. Any entries consisting solely of or expressing political viewpoints, or causes will not be allowed.
- 6. No objects are to be thrown from any vehicle or by marchers. The distribution of literature, samples, fruit, candy or gifts of any kind is strictly forbidden. This will result in immediate removal from parade. (City regulations forbid the throwing/tossing of materials from parade entries to crowd on sidelines.)
- 7. Floats: All floats must meet LA City Fire Departments maximum safety requirements per SECS7.22.05 LA Municipal Code below. Parade floats using decorative materials attached to vehicles shall be constructed of non-combustible or flame-retardant materials and shall be safeguarded against open flame in accordance with the provisions of this section.
 - A. All float decorations shall be flame retardant, flame retardant treated, or non-Combustible if of 1/8-inch or less. The use of materials treated with tar or petroleum base flammable products or surfaced or covered with lacquers, highly flammable paints, cellophane, and similar materials are prohibited. Paper, cloth, textiles, and vegitation which may occasion or a fire hazard, shall be rendered flame retardant.
 - B. The use of open flame devices is prohibited unless approval in writing by the Chief. Smoke producing devices must be of the non-heating type.
 - C. Exhaust pipes shall be extended beyond the display area and shall be properly protected.
 - D. Parade Floats shall have a portable fire extinguisher with a minimum of 2A, 10B:C rating. The extinguisher shall be readily accessible to the operator.
- 8. Drivers must have a valid driver's license and your vehicle must carry evidence of insurance while traveling on the parade route during the Veterans Day Parade. It Is Understood All Subcontractors, parade participants And Vendors Will Provide A Certificate Of Insurance Naming San Fernando Valley Veterans Day Parade Inc. As An Additional Insured.
- 9. There should be no riders on vehicles or on parts of vehicles not designed for passengers (such as fenders or hoods.)
- San Fernando Valley Veterans Day Parade Inc., planning committee reserves the right to refuse any application or unit entry. EXCEPT for SCHOOL BANDS, SCHOOL MARCHING COLOR GUARDS and DRILL TEAMS, SCHOOL JROTC UNITS, and YOUTH MILITARY UNITS (ie...Nava1 Sea Cadets, CA Cadet corps, & Jr. Marines)
 NON-VETERAN APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED
- 11. The parade committee accepts no responsibility for improper or false statements made by parade entrants.
- 12. The parade committee decision on entry acceptance is final. Rule waivers must be approved by the committee in at least one week prior to the parade.
- 13. Violation of parade rules or governmental regulations will subject entry to immediate disqualification and removal from parade.
- 14. The parade is limited to the streets shown on the MAP enclosed. Please do not leave this route.
- 15. Public address systems are encouraged for music purposes only; it must not interfere with other units.
- 16. <u>VETERANS WITH FAMILY MEMBERS AND ONLY VETERANS WITH FAMILY MEMBERS RIDE IN THIS PARADE.</u>

Dear Parade Participant (s):

This letter serves as your CONFIRMATION for your entry's participation in the 19th Annual San Fernando Valley Veterans Day Parade.

THE PARADE WILL PROMPTLY BEGIN @ 11:11am, November 11, 2022 PARADE ROUTE: The parade will begin at the corner of Laurel Canyon Blvd. and San Fernando Mission Blvd in Mission Hills and will proceed south on Laurel Canyon Blvd. for 1.1 miles and end at Paxton Street in Pacoima.

PLEASE REVIEW THE ENCLOSED MAPAND FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- Fire Trucks, LAV's, Humvees, Private Vehicle's and Floats enter the parade staging area from Rinaldi Street at Laurel Canyon Boulevard.
- <u>Bands</u> enter the parade staging area from Sepulveda Blvd. to San Fernando Mission Blvd. at Sharp Ave. <u>Parade Staff</u> will meet and escort your band to the assigned area.
- **Equestrians** enter the parade staging area from San Fernando Rd. to San Fernando Mission Blvd. at Acala Ave in the staging Area (see map).
- Participants not driving a Fire Truck, not driving a LAV, not driving their own Private Vehicle but are walking, or part of an ROTC group or riding on a Float; they must park at lot 2 (located on map) and adjacent streets. It is strongly recommended participants carpool and arrive early at the limited parking lot.
- Handicapped parking will be available at the Ritchie Valens Recreation Center, at 10736 Laurel Canyon Boulevard Pacoima, CA 91331 in lot 1 (see map). Once parked, please make your way over to the front of the Ritchie Valens Recreation Center where a shuttle will transport participants to the designated staging area starting at 8:15am. Last shuttle departs at 10:15am.
- CHECK-IN will begin at 7:30 am and will close at 10:30 am SHARP.
- Only (1) one representative per group is required to check-in at the parking lot at the Carl's Jr. Restaurant @ 11509 Laurel Canyon Blvd., San Fernando, CA.
- The assigned representative will receive:
 - 1. Entry Identification Number placed on the right side of the entry/unit.
 - 2. One ticket for each participant that is redeemable for one hot dog & drink at the conclusion of the parade at the Ritchie Valens Recreation Center.
 - **3.** One ticket for each Veteran participant that is redeemable for a commemorative T-shirt and pin in the registration area.

REMEMBER: Drivers must have a valid driver's license and your vehicle must carry evidence of insurance while traveling on the parade route during the Veterans Day Parade.
